

OWL – Flap Your Wings

Materials needed:

- Cardboard (cereal box)
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Markers/crayons/colored pencils
- Single hole punch
- String or yarn, 1 yard-ish
- 2 brads/paper fasteners
- Glue
- Awl (sharp object for punching holes)

Steps:

- Trace patterns on cardboard
- Decorate pieces as desired
- Cut out
- Punch holes
- Glue back and front eye to body, covering punched holes. Re-punch eye holes after glue dries.
- Insert brads/paper fasteners through eye holes.
- Cut 16” of string/yarn. Insert and tie each end through hole B in wings.
- Attach wings to body on brad/paper fastener through hole A. Loosely open the brad so wings flap freely.
- Fold, make crease in beak. Glue to body.
- Attach remaining string/yarn through hole punch at top of body.
- Flap away!
