OWL – Flap Your Wings

Materials needed:

- · Cardboard (cereal box)
- · Scissors
- · Pencil
- · Markers/crayons/colored pencils
- · Single hole punch
- String or yarn, 1 yard-ish
- · 2 brads/paper fasteners
- · Glue
- Awl (sharp object for punching holes)

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Steps:

- · Trace patterns on cardboard
- · Decorate pieces as desired
- · Cut out
- · Punch holes
- Glue back and front eye to body, covering punched holes. Re-punch eye holes after glue dries.
- · Insert brads/paper fasteners through eye holes.
- Cut 16" of string/yarn. Insert and tie each end through hole B in wings.
- Attach wings to body on brad/paper fastener through hole A. Loosely open the brad so wings flap freely.
- · Fold, make crease in beak. Glue to body.
- Attach remaining string/yarn through hole punch at top of body.
- · Flap away!
