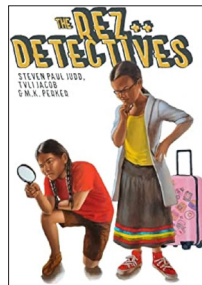


Featured Author: Steven Paul Judd
